Application Procedures:

All surfaces must be clean, dry and free of all loose materials. Apply with a standard caulking gun. Cut the nozzle to desired bead size and puncture the inner seal. Apply at a 45% angle using constant pressure. For ease of gunning, use at room temperature. Tool or join surfaces for sealing before material skins. Support tooled or joined surfaces for 8 hours minimum. Use Mineral Spirits or VM&P Naphtha to remove excess material before skin forms. Clean up with VM&P Naphtha or Mineral Spirits.

Limitations:

All surfaces to be sealed or bonded must be clean, dry and free from contaminants. Primer may be required for certain surfaces.
